Come to share a warm fire, warm cocoa, and warm conversations. A special visitor may even come to share in the festivities as well...

**WHEN:** December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Hot cocoa served from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM, dutch oven cobbler at 6:30. Special visitor may show up around 7:00 PM.

**WHERE:** Kershaw Ryan State Park, 2 miles south of Caliente on SR 317.
