Mesquite Police Department Receives Grant Funds to Participate in the Joining Forces Program

Mesquite Police Department is pleased to announce its participation in the Joining Forces traffic safety campaign that combines 37 law enforcement agencies across the State of Nevada focused on traffic safety awareness and enforcement. The campaign series will run from October 2025 through September 2026.

He continued, “Participating in the Joining Forces campaign allows more opportunities to prevent traffic incidents and educate the public on safe driving practices.
